Good day Fellow Kingscross Resident & Neighbour:

Who is KRA?

KRA was founded & incorporated as a not-forprofit organisation in 2011. KRA was set up by Brian Pritchard, John Hollick, Peter McCarthy & Wilson Markle to represent the voters & ratepayers in Kingscross Estates to influence government decisions which may affect all residents.

Over the years KRA has challenged the "Culotta" development on its northern boundary (opposite Villanova College), a severance within Kingscross, the Mansions of King (MOK) (65+ homes & Townhouses) & Bushland Heights (BH) (85 homes) developments on its western & southern boundaries.

Funds were raised to pay lawyers, planners & hydrogeologists consistent with the purposes of KRA when incorporated.

The developers of MOK & BH, which border Manitou Drive, Kingscross Drive, Champlain Crescent & Jane St., are responding to the conditions set for their developments prior to obtaining approval to build. Those conditions included "wins" for KRA i.e., the prohibition of a road link from MOK to Manitou & a requirement for the monitoring of the private wells in Kingscross prior to & after development. Construction is unlikely before 2025 at the earliest.

Highlights of KRAs priorities & accomplishments 2023-2024

(post-Covid)

- Growing KRA by engaging the neighbourhood e.g., Crime Prevention Meeting with YRP, Annual Spring Clean Up on April 21, A Spring Evening at Pine Farms on May 10, Community walks of the King City Trails, the AGM & Board Elections in June 2024.
- Encouraging participation of homes in a well-monitoring program associated with MOK.
- Monitoring the "ready to build" status of MOK & BH & their compliance with the conditions for development through periodic meetings with the Township.
- Worked with our local Councillor Debbie Schaefer to implement-over \$300,000 work, done by the Township & TRCA over two years, to prevent flooding of properties at Kingscross/ Manitou.
